

Wheel Nail Trimming with Sandpaper



Marking the sandpaper placement

- Lay sandpaper on track where you want it mounted
- Mark the spots on sandpaper with pencil/pen
- Using a hole punch, punch holes or poke to make a hole

Installing the sandpaper on your wheel

Lay the sandpaper on the outside of the track

Use one nut and bolt in each corner of the sandpaper

- From the inside of the wheel
- Push bolt through the track
- Do this at each corner

Tighten nut onto the bolt

Make sure the head of the bolt is inside the wheel and the nut is placed on the outside.

If you decide to use two pieces of sandpaper, place the second directly across from the first.

NOTE: It is very important that you check the bottoms of your pet's feet/pads periodically to make sure they are not becoming irritated by the use of the trimmer inserts.

Some say to not leave the sandpaper on the track for long periods of time and other's use it constantly.

If the rough surface of the sandpaper becomes an irritation, you can alternate it when cleaning the wheel. Example: On one week and off the next.

Do not cover the entire track with sandpaper.

Using sandpaper as a trimmer allows a little more time between manicures. This is not a substitution for regular maintenance and manicures.
